

Listening for digraphs: Ask your child to read aloud the sound made by the digraph in the middle circle (or read it aloud for him). Ask him to name each picture and draw a line connecting the digraph to each word that contains it.



Tip for parents: Say a string of words and ask your child to knock on the table with his fist each time he hears the *ck* sound at the end of the word. Tell him not to knock if he doesn't hear the *ck* sound.
