

Listening for digraphs: Ask your child to read aloud the sound made by the digraph in the middle circle (or read it aloud for him). Ask him to name each picture and draw a line connecting the digraph to each word that contains it.



Tip for parents: Look for rhymes such as Old King Cole or Ring Around the Rosey. When you read the rhymes, ask your child to point to each word that has *ng* in the middle or ending of the word.
