

Listening for digraphs: Ask your child to read aloud the sound made by the digraph in the middle circle (or read it aloud for him). Ask him to name each picture and draw a line connecting the digraph to each word that contains it.

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Tip for parents: Name some behaviors for your child, such as “making your bed” or “grabbing toys.” Ask your child to use the phrase “should do” or “should not do” to label each activity.
