

Listening for digraphs: Ask your child to read aloud the sound made by the digraph in the middle circle (or read it aloud for him). Ask him to name each picture and draw a line connecting the digraph to each word that contains it.

Tip for parents: Reinforce the sound of the “th” digraph by looking through a toy catalog with your child. Ask him to use the phrases “I like this” and “I don’t like that” as you look at each toy.
