

**Identifying words in a sentence:** Read each sentence with your child, pointing to words as you read. Then ask your child to count the number of words in each sentence and circle or say the number.

I like soup.

1 2 3

The house is blue.

3 4 5

The door is heavy.

4 5 6

I am hungry.

2 3 4

**Tip for parents:** When reading aloud to your child, take time to point out the punctuation in each sentence. Explain that a comma tells you when to take a short pause and a period tells you when to take a long pause.
