

**Tracing the letter c:** Direct your child to hold the pencil firmly between his thumb and index finger, resting it on his middle finger for support. The arrows indicate the proper and easiest construction of the letter.

**Tip for parents:** Explain to your child that the letter c is one smooth curve, starting just below the dashed line and ending just above the solid line at the bottom. It is identical to the uppercase C, only smaller.
