



Tracing the letter p: Direct your child to hold the pencil firmly between his thumb and index finger, resting it on his middle finger for support. The arrows indicate the proper and easiest construction of the letter.

Tip for parents: Unlike the uppercase P, this letter is made in one stroke. Direct your child to keep the pencil on the paper after drawing the first downward line and simply retrace that line before drawing a loop at the top.
