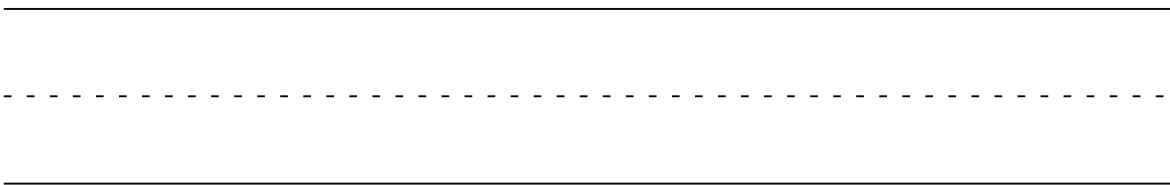
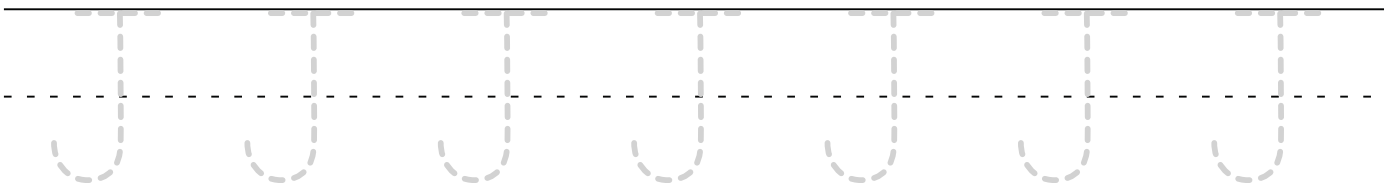
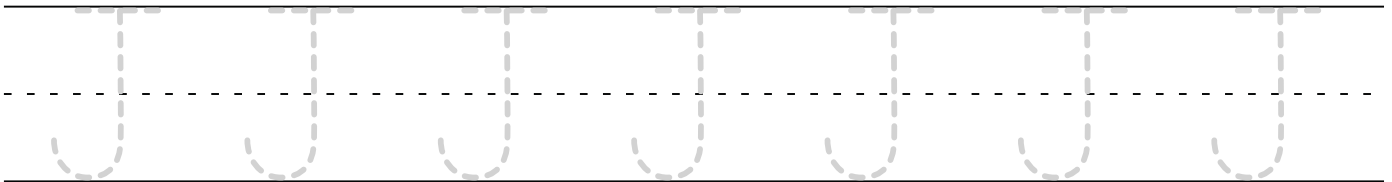
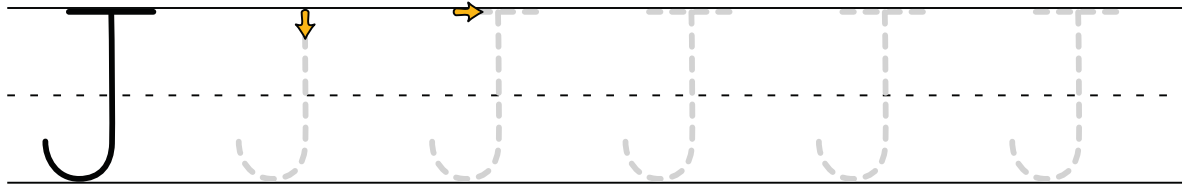




Tracing the letter J: Direct your child to hold the pencil firmly between his thumb and index finger, resting it on his middle finger for support. The arrows indicate the proper and easiest construction of the letter.



Tip for parents: While most writing requires children to draw from left to right, a J requires the opposite movement. As your child's vertical line nears the bottom line of the paper, direct him to "hook" backwards to the left.
